Happy New Year!

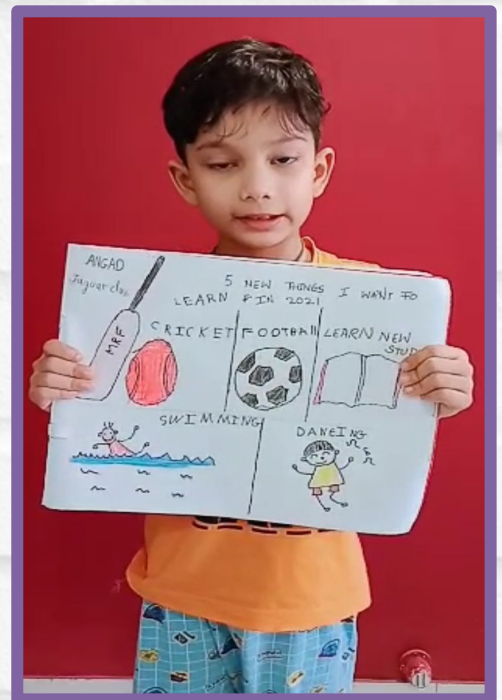

The Promise of the Year Ahead

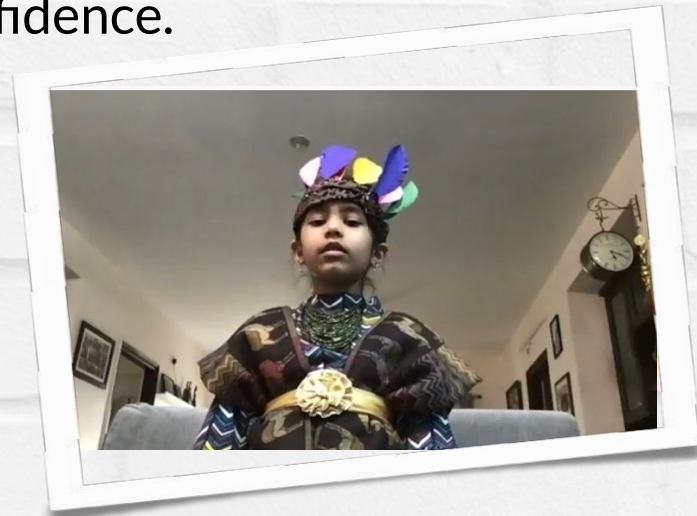
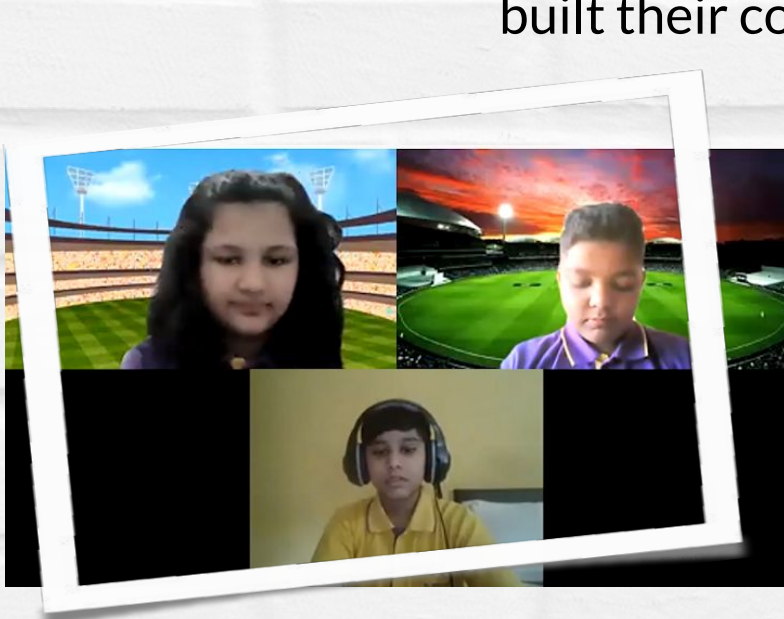
Last year was full of fear

Events: Infinite- An Array of Learning

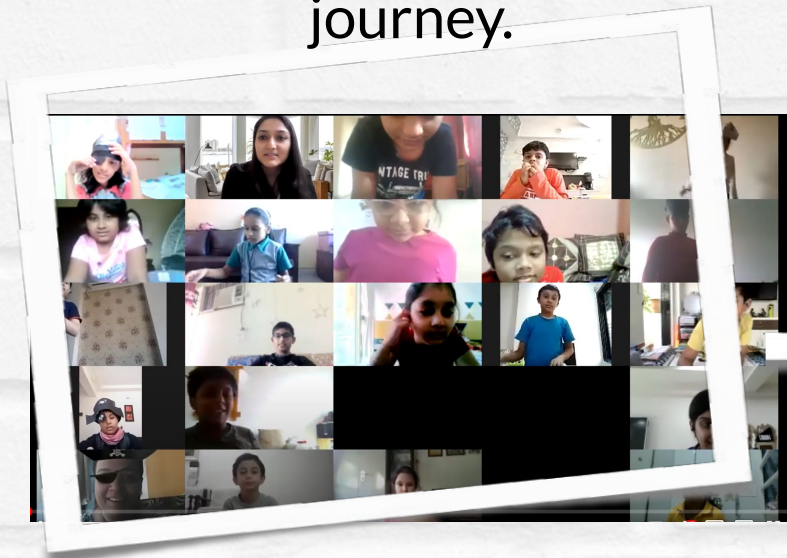
